\*\*\*\*Students who intend to transfer to MTSU or University of Memphis do not need to take this course. Instead students are encouraged to take additional physical education activity elective courses.

\*\*\*\*\*Students who intend to transfer to TTU should take Educational Psychology and an additional 4 credit hour Natural Science course with lab that completes a Natural Science General Education sequence.
