NOTES:

1. Students who plan to transfer to the UoM must complete at least one fine arts under the Humanities & Fine Arts general education requirement. Students planning to transfer to MTSU can take an approved Anthropology course in either the Humanities & Fine Arts or in an Area of Emphasis.
2. Students who plan to transfer to TTU and UTK must complete a natural science sequence.
3. Consult the academic catalog or an advisor at your transferring institution to determine if this History elective course may count towards your intended transfer major or as a general elective.
4. Students who plan to transfer to UTK will be required to demonstrate intermediate-level competency in Foreign Language before graduating from UTK. Students may demonstrate intermediate-level competence after transferring to UTK.
5. Students planning to attend MTSU should take one early and one modern History course. Students planning to attend TTU can choose from any of the four courses listed to complete this area of emphasis requirement.
